HALLOWEEN DISCO!

Any child not participating in the KS2 disco should be collected at home time in the usual way.

Prizes will be given out for the best costumes at the end of the disco! Parents are requested to wait just outside school at the main entrance, at the end of the disco they will be invited in to collect their child from their usual classroom. Pupils will not be allowed to walk home unaccompanied.
