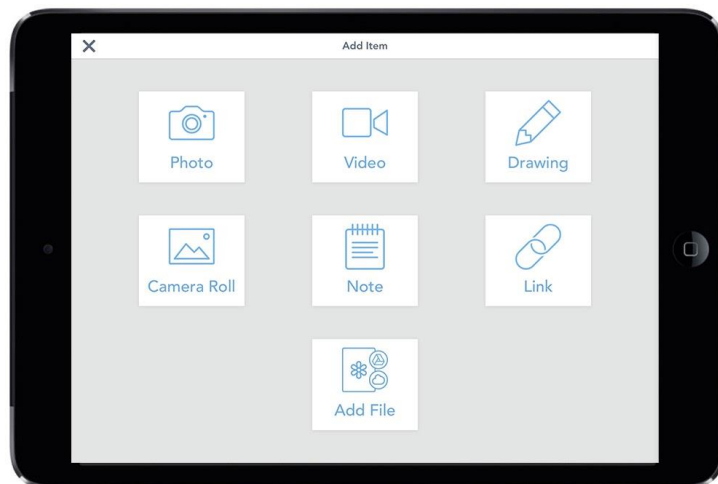




At Parkhead we use Seesaw from Year 1 to Year 6. Seesaw is a tool that allows children to record all of the learning they're doing at school and add it to a journal so it can be shared with their family and teachers. We also use it to set home learning activities and to allow children to share their learning from home.

Each student has a unique Home Learning Code to access Seesaw. When signing in with their Home Learning Code, students can post to their journal, respond to activities, and view class announcements. These will be sent home with your child at the beginning of each year. Please contact your child's teacher if you lose this code and they can provide you with a new one.

Seesaw is designed to be used easily and independently by pupils of all ages. It allows children to type, draw, take photos and videos, record voice notes and add files or links.



How to Access Seesaw

You can access Seesaw in a number of ways.

- 1) Go to <https://app.seesaw.me> on a computer. Or install the Seesaw **Class App** on an iOS or Android device.



2. Choose "I'm a Student".



3. Scan the QR code using Seesaw's built-in QR code scanner. Or type in the letters on your login information to access you child's Seesaw account.
