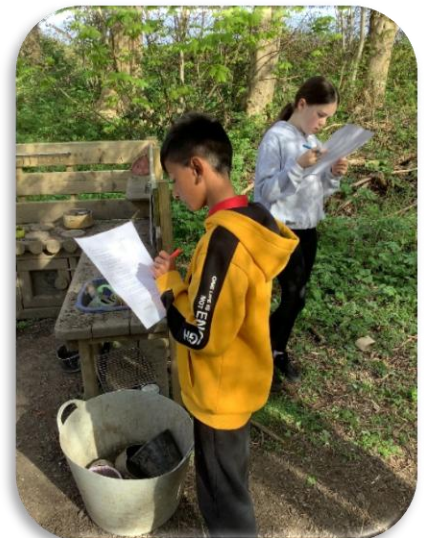
KLUBZ:
